The Tasmania Police Golf Club is the proud host of the Australian Police Golf Championships in Hobart from Sunday the 1st of March to Friday the 6th of March 2009.

In 2009 competitors will be playing at two of Tasmania's finest golf courses, the Royal Hobart Golf Club and the Tasmania Golf Club.

The courses are situated near the Hobart Airport at Seven Mile Beach and Barilla Bay, a 20 minute drive from Hobart.

Royal Hobart Golf Club had its origins in 1896 as Newlands Golf Club (later to become the Hobart Golf Club).



In 1963 the Club moved to its present site at Seven Mile Beach. The course was designed by acclaimed Course Architect, Mr. Vern Morcom, constructed on sandy soil, of gentle contour, and set most attractively in native bushland. It remains one of the finest courses in Australia.

The Club has hosted numerous Tasmanian Opens, National Amateur events and the Australian Open (1971) won by the legendary Jack Nicklaus.

Royal Hobart Golf Club has been home to some of Australia's great golfers namely Bruce and Clyde Pearce, Elvie Whiteside, and in more recent times Lindy Goggin, Peter Toogood and current US PGA member Mathew Goggin.

Royal Hobart's championship layout measures 6,133 metres with an ACR rating of 72. The course is rated in the top 100 Australian Golf Courses, coming in at number 56.

Bounded by water on three sides, the spectacular Tasmania Golf Club course is set on the picturesque Barilla Bluff, where it has been since 1971. Narrow tree lined fairways are augmented by superb panoramic views with large rolling greens and strategically placed green side bunkers.



The course was created by curator Ian Grimsey under the guidance of noted course architect Mr Al Howard. The feature hole of the course is the par 5, 3rd hole. From the championship markers it is awe inspiring and has been more than favourably compared to the notorious 18th hole at California's Pebble Beach.

However, this is just one of 18 challenging holes in a well balanced combination of par 3's, 4's and 5's for golfers of all standards to enjoy. In 1999 the magnificent course was rated as Tasmania's best with an ACR of 73 for men and an AWCR 74 for ladies. The course is a par 72 of 6200 metres for men and par 74 of 5531 for ladies. The course is rated in the top 100 Australian Golf Courses, coming in at number 45.

The Tasmania Golf Club is very proud of its reputation locally interstate and internationally for its physical beauty and as an excellent test of golfing ability. The course is only 5 minutes from the Hobart Airport and 20 minutes from the city of Hobart.
